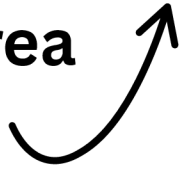
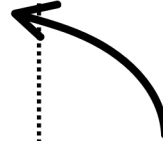


Safe Print Area

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Fold Line



Cut Line



DIRECTIONS

Print using letter sized paper -
double sided on the long side
(do a test print first)

Cut in half

Fold now disconnected halves
hamburger style and make sure the
page numbers are in order

Staple in the middle

*MN Statute 617.262 states that anyone who shares these images without consent can be charged with a gross misdemeanor and serve up to 3 years in prison, pay a \$5,000 fine, or both. *Other laws around sharing porn with minors or making deepfakes of minors may also apply.

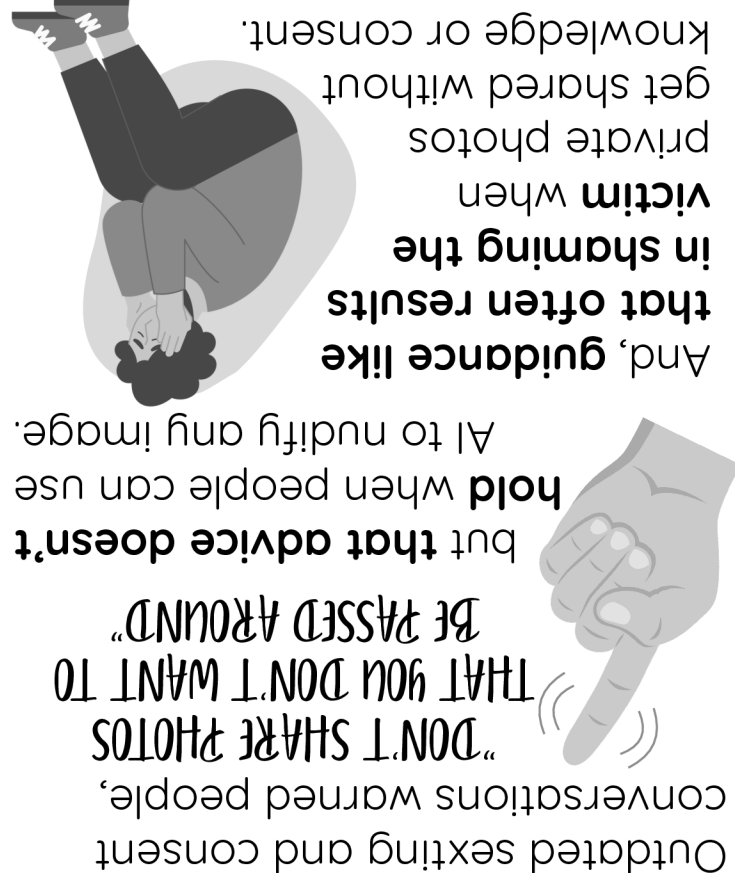

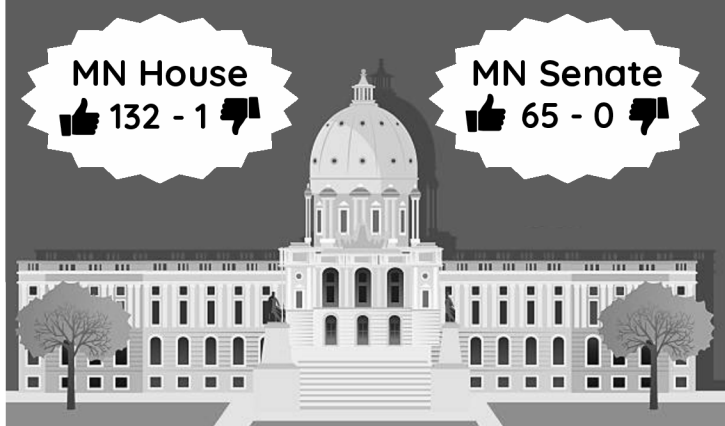

Minnesota lawmakers passed the **country's first law banning the use and advertising of AI nudification apps** or tools to make nude images of a person or people without their consent.

It's time we update our **consent conversations** to inform people on the harm and legal risk of using these AI tools to make and share nudified images of others.
